This year's program comprises of the Richard Linklater "Before Series" and is a genuine trilogy having the one story extended over the three films. Even more fascinating is that the three films were shot nine years apart using the same lead actors, so the actors themselves age with the story.

Julie Delpy and Ethan Hawke excel as the two main characters, Celine and Jesse, in all three of these films. The story will leave you in suspense between each film and longing for the next episode.

We will also have the great privilege of having Jake Wilson (film reviewer from The Age) give an introduction to each film and a Q&A session at the end of the day.
