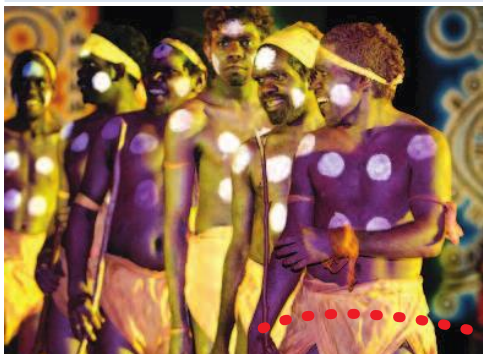

Annual Membership \$60 (full) \$55 (concession) \$30 (Youth under 25)

Full and concession memberships taken from May will be at a pro-rata rate. New members joining for the May screening will pay \$50 (full) and \$45 (concession) for the remaining 8 months. The cost will then drop by \$5 per month until the minimum 3 month membership period is reached in October. Youth pro rata rates commence in July.

CHANGES TO THE FILM SOCIETY DVD LIBRARY TERMS AND CONDITIONS.

Hello members, last night we have had our regular committee meeting and collectively we have realised that our DVD library needs a structural makeover. We realised this because presently the Library's Terms and Conditions do not reflect the values that the Film Society places on film and the film industry. The movies in our DVD Libraries are selected deliberately and provided voluntarily and freely to all members.

Therefore, we have implemented some changes to your lending requirements effective immediately, for both Warburton and Healesville lending libraries.

1) All items in the library are on a **monthly loan**, from film night to film night. Returns therefore are due on the Tuesday. If you are not attending the film night when the DVD is due, you will need to a) drop it into the cinema on or before the day or b) entrust it to someone that is attending the film.

2) A limit of three films per month.

3) Extensions can be granted up to one day before the film is due. Extensions of up to a month will be offered.

4) DVD's that are not returned within the conditions above **will be charged \$20 replacement fee each** and no further films will be borrowed until paid or the film/s returned. (The reason for this T&C is that we discovered a lot of films simply not

accounted for, which begs for a structural overhaul to the system.) You may contact Anne Ligthart (0466 599 837) for the Warburton DVD Library or Seth Hynes (number?) for the Healesville DVD Library.

These changes also apply to films that are currently overdue. We invite you to bring your films back next week at the latest or request an extension.

May be warmly remind you that the borrowing of our films is a privilege that reflects our values as a Film Society, as is the Library itself. Those people that manage the libraries from season to season are happy volunteers that do so because of the value placed on film. The new T&C's will now reflect this value and privilege that we all enjoy through the free usage of our DVD Film Libraries.
